

Organ systems and the tissues they include.

Organ System	Tissues within that system
Cardiovascular	Includes heart and blood vessels.
Digestive / Intestinal	Includes any portion of the intestines (esophagus, stomach, small intestines, large intestines).
Endocrine	Includes pancreas, adrenal, pituitary, pineal, thyroid, parathyroid glands, and chemorreceptor organs.
Hemo-lymphatic / Lymphoid	Includes bone marrow, spleen, lymph nodes, thymus, and tonsils.
Hepatic / Biliary	Includes liver, gallbladder, and biliary tree.
Integumentary / Skin	Includes haired and non-haired skin, subcutaneous fat and fat pads, mammary glands, and external ears.
Musculoskeletal	Includes striated (skeletal) muscle, bones, and joints.
Neuro	Includes brain (cerebrum, cerebellum), spinal cord, ganglia, and nerves.
Reproductive	Includes male and female reproductive organs.
Respiratory	Includes trachea, bronchi, lungs, air sacs, and gills.
Special Senses	Includes eyes, inner ear, and olfactory apparatuses.
Urinary	Includes kidneys, ureters, urinary bladder, and urethra.

Other	Includes cell cultures (including matrices) and tissue organoids.
