How to use the microscopy service

The HMGU Core Facility Pathology and Tissue Analytics (CF-PTA) is a central service platform offering access to state-of-the-art technical and professional services in pathology and microscopy for all aspects of morphological tissue-analysis. This includes extensive support in image data analysis and access to tailored training. The service is open to internal and external customers on a fee for service basis.

Before using the **Microscopy Services of CF-PTA** for the first time and when starting a new project please complete the following steps to gain access to instruments and services:

1. Initial project meeting at an early stage

2. Project proposal

Further the submission of a project proposal is required. Please include any information needed to provide a clear understanding of your goals and expectations of your project as well as a valid form of payment and email to annette.feuchtinger@helmholtz-muenchen.de . The project will only be scheduled upon final review of the form by CF-PTA.

3. Training

For use of **self-service instruments** in CF-PTA users must obtain **training**. Please submit a **training request** and acknowledge to acceptance of our guidelines. Complete any mandatory training for multi-user microscopes prior to first independent usage.
